The Mode of Baptism

In our religious world, there are three modes of baptism one can choose. A person can have water poured on him; he may be sprinkled with water, or he may be fully immersed. As we study this subject, we must ask, “What says the Scriptures?” (Rom. 5:4). Concerning the biblical mode of baptism, we noticed last week that Mark 1:9-10 and John 3:23 insisted that baptism was only by full body immersion. Let us notice two other passages that teach the proper mode of baptism is by immersion.

Romans 6:4 “We were buried with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.” In this passage, the Apostle Paul compares baptism to a burial. Let us think about this for a moment. When a person goes to a funeral the body is placed under the ground six feet and dirt is covering it on all sides. This is a perfect picture of the mode of baptism. When a person is baptized according to the Scriptures, he is placed all the way under the water and water must be covering him on each side. No one would ever say that a sprinkling or pouring of dirt on a body is a proper burial. Why then will we say that a person can be sprinkled or poured for baptism today? There is no authority in the New Testament for any mode of baptism except immersion.

Acts 8:30-39 In the example of Philip and the Ethiopian eunuch, the Eunuch requested to be baptized. Here is what happened in this divine example. “And he commanded the chariot to stop, and they both went down into the water, Philip and the Eunuch, and he baptized him (Acts 8:38).” When studying this example, one must wonder why both the Eunuch and Philip had to go down into the water. This man is

traveling on a long journey from Jerusalem to Egypt. Surely, he would have some drinking water with him. Why did they not just use it? Why did Philip not go down to the water and bring a handful back? In this example, both men went down into the water and both came up out of the water. This is a clear picture of baptism by full body immersion. From this lesson, we can learn that first century baptism was performed by immersion.

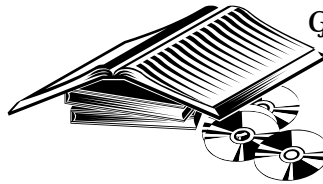

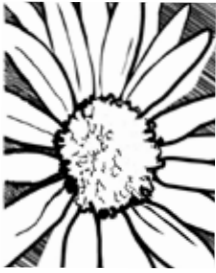
